Current status

The total number of active resident and employee cases of COVID-19 at Aspen is now zero. We are still considered in outbreak until otherwise notified by Alberta Health Services. We will inform you once that happens.

Reminders

- <u>City and provincial mandates state it is mandatory to wear a mask when</u> you are in common (public) indoor spaces. When guests are in resident suites, we recommend you both wear masks, even if you are vaccinated.

- Please contact Reception to schedule indoor visits. Outdoor visits do not need to be scheduled.
- The tuck shop and hair salon are both open. Please contact the salon at 403-617-1860 to schedule an appointment.
- Participants in Active Aging group programs must wear masks and maintain physical distance.
- If you have an essential medical appointment scheduled, call the provider to say you are coming from a community in confirmed outbreak.
- Self-monitor for symptoms; advise Reception if you are symptomatic.
