## Reminders

- <u>City and provincial mandates state it is mandatory to wear a mask when</u> you are in common (public) indoor spaces.

- If you have an essential medical appointment scheduled, call the provider to say you are coming from a community in confirmed outbreak.
- Self-monitor for symptoms; advise Reception if you are symptomatic.
