The total number of active resident and employee cases of COVID-19 at Bow Valley remains at one. We'll let you know if that number changes.

Friendly reminders

- We are strongly requesting that all visitors are fully vaccinated. Vaccination status can be shown at the reception desk during the health screening process. If you are unvaccinated, outdoor visits or virtual visits are the best option. Visitors and residents must wear masks during both indoor and outdoor visits.
- Please contact Reception to schedule indoor visits.
- Silvera employees are monitoring resident temperatures twice daily as per recommendations from Public Health.
- Smaller Active Aging group programs are still moving forward for vaccinated residents who are masked and distanced.
- If you have an essential medical appointment scheduled, inform the provider you are coming from a community in confirmed outbreak.
- Self-monitor for symptoms, let an employee know if you are symptomatic.
