



**Beaverdam outbreak update 2 – Tuesday, Oct. 12, 2021**

Hello Beaverdam residents and primary contacts,

The total number of active resident and employee cases of COVID-19 at Beaverdam remains at four. We'll let you know if that number changes.

Residents in the North Wing remain in isolation until further notice. They will be tested a second time on Friday afternoon, Oct. 15.

We stress that all resident visitors, especially those that provide essential supports to their loved ones, are fully vaccinated to reduce the level of risk for all Beaverdam residents. Outbreak restrictions take a toll on residents whose essential support visitors are restricted from entering community, specifically those residents who do not receive Home Care. Those residents who lack such supports are unfortunately at risk of moving to higher levels of care sooner than if they had in-community supports.

Visits are still permitted with non-isolating residents. Please remind your loved one that all residents must wear masks when they are outside of their suites or while another person is inside their suite.

We will provide another update once we have received the results from our next round of testing. Thank you,
