Hello Aspen residents and primary contacts:

I'm delighted to let you know this morning the Calgary Zone Medical Officer of Health (MOH) has declared Aspen to be out of gastrointestinal outbreak.

Enhanced cleaning protocols will remain in place for the next 72 hours as we continue to monitor residents.

As we all know, our outbreak situation can change at any time, despite our many precautions. We must continue to be vigilant in our combined efforts to minimize the spread of viruses in our community.

Just a reminder that residents are asked to wear masks when outside of their suites.

Additionally, a reminder that all visitors to Aspen are now required to show proof of full COVID-19 vaccination along with photo ID.
