



## **Beaverdam outbreak update 4 – Friday, January 7, 2022**

Hello Beaverdam residents and primary contacts,

### ***Current status***

Fifteen residents are still isolating with gastrointestinal and/or COVID-19 symptoms. There are now two confirmed resident cases and two confirmed employee cases of COVID-19 at Beaverdam. Alberta Health Services is expected to test all residents for COVID-19 today. As AHS is extremely busy, it may take several days to get test results.

### ***Reminders***

- We recommend rescheduling medical appointments for now. If a resident must go to a medical appointment, you are required to disclose to the provider the resident is coming from a community in confirmed COVID-19 and GI outbreaks.
- Extra housekeeping services are in place to help manage the extra cleaning and sanitizing required. We continue to assist affected residents who are isolating in their suites. We are providing meal/tray service and personal care to affected residents.
- Visits are still permitted with non-isolating residents. Visitors and residents must wear masks for the duration of all visits. Visitors must provide proof of full COVID-19 vaccination before entering community. Virtual visits are also an option.
- Please remind your loved one to wear their mask as much as possible, fully covering their mouth and nose.
- Please remind residents to wash their hands frequently.
