Hello Beaverdam residents and primary contacts,

Current status

There are now two confirmed resident cases and three confirmed employee cases of COVID-19 at Beaverdam. Five residents are still isolating, pending COVID-19 test results from Alberta Health Services. We are awaiting results from Friday's testing of all residents.

Reminders

- Residents may see new faces around the community as additional service providers are providing support during the outbreak.
- If a resident must go to an essential medical appointment, please remember to disclose to the provider the resident is coming from a community in confirmed COVID-19 and GI outbreaks.
- We continue to assist residents who are isolating in their suites, providing them with meal/tray service and personal care.
- Visits are still permitted with non-isolating residents. Visitors and residents must wear masks for the duration of all visits. Visitors must provide proof of full COVID-19 vaccination before entering community. Virtual visits are also an option.
- Please remind your loved one to wear their mask as much as possible, fully covering their mouth and nose.
- Please remind residents to wash their hands frequently.
