Hello Beaverdam residents and primary contacts,

Current status

Category of case	Residents	Employees

Cumulative recovered	0	3

Two residents had initial symptoms that have now abated. The other four have had no symptoms at all but were found positive after all residents were tested. Employees are being tested regularly by Alberta Health Services (AHS) as a precaution.

The GI outbreak is now over, but we remain in COVID-19 outbreak, and all residents will be tested again in the coming days.

Reminders

- Residents may see new faces around the community as additional service providers are providing support during the outbreak.
- If a resident must go to an essential medical appointment, please remember to disclose to the provider the resident is coming from a community in confirmed COVID-19 outbreak.
- We continue to assist residents who are isolating in their suites, providing them with meal/tray service and personal care.
- Visits are still permitted with non-isolating residents. Visitors and residents must wear masks for the duration of all visits. Visitors must provide proof of full COVID-19 vaccination before entering community. Virtual visits are also an option.

- Please remind your loved one to wear their mask as much as possible, fully covering their mouth and nose.
- Please remind residents to wash their hands frequently.
