Today's updates

- Alberta Health Services will provide in-community COVID-19 testing for residents. We do not yet know when this will occur. Please note that AHS is currently extremely busy testing many Albertans who have displayed COVID-like symptoms. It can take several days to be tested and wait times for results may be delayed.
- Please continue to distance from others and to always wear a mask when outside of your suite, or if anyone is inside your suite, including Silvera employees or health care aides.
- Housekeeping is sanitizing three times each day in the suites of isolating residents. We continue enhanced cleaning throughout the community.
- Visitors are still permitted for non-isolating residents. Virtual visits are available for isolating residents – please contact Reception for help to set these up.
- Activities continue but are limited to 10 people with masks.
- Please self-monitor for any COVID-19, cold or gastrointestinal symptoms and report them to Reception: 403-256-4036.

If you have a medical appointment scheduled, please inform the healthcare provider that you are coming from a community that is in a Confirmed COVID-19 Outbreak.

We will update you again on Friday unless there are significant changes before then.
