Fever	Chills
Cough	Muscle/joint aches
Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing	Nausea/vomiting/diarrhea/unexplained loss of appetite
Runny nose	Feeling unwell/fatigued
Nasal congestion	Headache
Sore throat	Loss of sense of smell or taste
Painful swallowing	Conjunctivitis/pink eye

- Please wear a medical-grade (not cloth) mask covering your nose and chin anytime you are out of your suite or if anyone is in your suite.
- We continue with enhanced cleaning protocols.
- If you have a medical appointment scheduled, inform the provider you are coming from a community in Confirmed COVID-19 Outbreak.
