



**Confirmed COVID-19 Outbreak declared at Beaverdam Commons**

Hello Beaverdam residents and primary contacts,

Results of the most recent swabs have confirmed that we have three residents who are COVID-19 positive, all of whom are in isolation. One resident, who had tested positive with COVID-19, has now recovered and is no longer required to isolate.

***Actions underway:***

Please monitor yourself for the following COVID-19 symptoms and, if you have any, isolate in your suite and inform Reception:

Fever	Chills
Cough	Muscle/joint aches
Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing	Nausea/vomiting/diarrhea/unexplained loss of appetite
Runny nose	Feeling unwell/fatigued
Nasal congestion	Headache
Sore throat	Loss of sense of smell or taste
Painful swallowing	Conjunctivitis/pink eye

- Wear a mask if you are outside your suite or if anyone is in your suite, including visitors, home care, housekeeping, or maintenance employees.
- All outbreak protocols are activated, and employees continue to wear personal protective equipment.
- If you have a medical appointment scheduled, please advise their office you are coming from a community in Confirmed COVID-19 Outbreak.
