Hello Bow Valley residents and primary contacts,

Alberta Health Services declared Bow Valley Commons to be in a Confirmed COVID-19 Outbreak. Three residents and one staff have tested positive for COVID-19.

Actions underway:

Please monitor yourself for the following COVID-19 symptoms and, if you have any, isolate in your suite and inform Reception:

- Continue to maintain proper hand hygiene by washing hands regularly or using hand sanitizer.
- If you have a medical appointment scheduled, please advise their office you are coming from a community in Confirmed COVID-19 Outbreak.
