

Confirmed COVID-19 Outbreak declared at Bow Valley Commons

Hello Bow Valley residents and primary contacts,

Alberta Health Services has declared Bow Valley to be in a Confirmed COVID-19 Outbreak. Six residents and two staff have tested positive for COVID-19. The residents and staff are isolating and there are currently no other symptomatic cases.

Please monitor yourself for the following COVID-19 symptoms and, if you have any, please isolate in your suite and inform Reception:

- Continue to maintain proper hand hygiene by washing hands regularly or using hand sanitizer.
- If you have a medical appointment scheduled, please advise their office you are coming from a community in Confirmed COVID-19 Outbreak.
