

Confirmed COVID-19 Outbreak declared at Spruce Commons

Hello Spruce residents and primary contacts:

This afternoon, Alberta Health Services declared Spruce Commons to be in a Confirmed COVID-19 Outbreak. 3 residents have tested positive for COVID-19 through rapid tests. Positive and symptomatic residents are isolating in their suites for a minimum of 5 days.

Actions underway

• We are working with Alberta Health Services to arrange testing for symptomatic residents tomorrow (Wednesday October 19, 2022).

• Please monitor yourself for the following COVID-19 symptoms and, if you have any, isolate in your suite and inform Reception:

Fever	Chills
Cough	Muscle/joint aches
Shortness of breath/difficulty	Nausea/vomiting/diarrhea/
breathing	unexplained loss of appetite
Runny nose	Feeling unwell/fatigued
Nasal congestion	Headache
Sore throat	Loss of sense of smell or taste
Painful swallowing	Conjunctivitis/pink eye

- Wear a mask if you are outside your suite or if anyone is in your suite, including visitors, home care, housekeeping, or maintenance employees.
- All outbreak protocols are activated, and employees continue to wear personal protective equipment.
- If you have a medical appointment scheduled, please advise their office you are coming from a community in Confirmed COVID-19 Outbreak.
