

Spruce outbreak update – Friday, October 21, 2022

This information is current as of October 21 at 2:00 p.m.

The total number of active resident cases of COVID-19 at Spruce is currently 13. As per current Alberta Health Service outbreak protocols, all symptomatic residents have been tested by rapid test or by AHS. We will provide results as soon as we receive them. No staff are showing symptoms or are COVID positive.

Today's update

- The dining room remains open, however the coffee stations have been temporarily closed. We will be serving coffee/snacks daily in the atrium at 10 am, 3 pm and 8 pm.
- Visitors are allowed in the building, but masks are recommended.
- Residents who test positive must isolate for five days. After five days, if symptoms subside, they are allowed out of the suite. AHS directs that for an additional five days they must do the following:
 - Wear a mask while in common areas
 - Return to their suite for meals.

Reminders

- It is recommended that all residents wear a mask anytime you leave your suite or when anybody enters your suite.
- Prior to attending medical appointments, please advise them that you are coming from a community in a Confirmed COVID-19 Outbreak.
- Please perform a self-check for symptoms each day. If you have new symptoms, please isolate and contact reception.
